A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

The functionality and access arrangements that Licensed Providers enjoy when accessing the Low Volume Interface (LVI) of the central systems are different from those enjoyed by Scottish Water in a number of respects, in terms of both the functionality available and the data which can be viewed. This means that it takes longer for the user, when checking a transaction or following up a query, to access a piece of information, which is time-consuming and inefficient, and does not make for a good user experience. It is understood that the same functionality can be made available to Scottish Water's users at little or no additional cost. The purpose of this paper is to propose that Scottish Water's users can have access to the same functionality in using the LVI as is available to the users from Licensed Providers.

Scottish Water is not seeking access to information it does not currently transact or receive, either through a transaction flow or through one of the regular reports from the CMA. Currently Scottish Water's LVI users can only access the Dashboard view of information. This allows the users to view all Scottish Water originating transactions and a number of Licensed Provider originating transactions. If a Scottish Water user wishes to view the reads submitted in respect of a meter via the LVI, the user must open and view each individual T005.3 transaction and gather the data, rather than being able to view all the meter read history on one screen as the Licensed Provider's user is able to do.

If the meter read values are changed by use of the retrospective amendment process, the individual T005.3s are not changed and Scottish Water's users have no way of viewing this change other than accessing the MDS and ERRAs reports.

General Description

This Change Proposal seeks to give Scottish Water’s users the ability to view the information contained in the SPID History Views available through the LVI, with the exclusion of Customer Name, Customer Name Type and LP ID fields on those views. Note – Scottish Water will continue to see the LP ID which it uses for operational purposes on the Dashboard and LP Lookup views.

The SPID History View consists of 3 different screens , namely SPID View, Meter View and Trade Effluent View and Scottish Water seeks access to all of these areas.

These screens will give access to additional data items via the LVI but the data items are ones which Scottish Water has transacted to the CMA or receives from the CMA either in reports or via transaction flows

The detailed arrangements regarding user access to the LVI are not spelled out in the CSDs. The attached table, which has been compiled with the assistance of the CMA, sets out whether the data item is available for view through the LVI. It is proposed that CSD is updated to identify which data items can be viewed via the LVI and by whom.

The CMA have suggested that they will update this for all market participants
