This Bulletin is to inform Market Participants of 4 Market Updates relating to the March 2015 Central Systems Software Release (v4.2) as follows:

- 1. The new Central Systems Software v4.2 will be released to the Central Systems Production Environment on Thursday 26 March 2015.
- 2. Availability of new User Roles
- 3. The final ERRA data submission prior to the release of the Central Systems Software v4.2.
- 4. Access to SAA Portal.
- 1. The new Central Systems Software version 4.2 will be released to the Central Systems Production Environment on Thursday 26 March 2015 after the Market closes at 18:00. The Market will open as normal at 08:00 on Friday 27 March 2015.

Accompanying this Bulletin is the v4.2 Software Release Note. This contains details of all of those changes being delivered.

- 2. Trading Parties wishing to utilise the new Retrospective Amendment User Roles should fill in an updated User Access form in the usual manner. This is now available on request from enquiries@cmascotland.co.uk.
- 3. The existing ERRA application process will cease on Thursday 26 March 2015. Any Trading Parties wishing to submit a change in data in the Central Systems via the existing Retrospective Amendment application process prior to the release of the new Central Systems on Thursday 26th March must provide the data to the CMA no later than <u>Friday 20th March 2015</u>. Trading Parties will be informed of any validation failures. Data should be provided in the same manner as all other ERRA requests.
- 4. Following the Software Release the Trading Parties will be able to view and click on SAA (UARN) reference data in the SPID View of the LVI. Clicking on a UARN will take you directly to the relevant page on the SAA website. Please note that on the SAA website that there is a limit of 5000 hits per

day from any single IP address. Should Trading Parties wish to have this limit removed they will need to deal directly with the SAA who can accommodate this if certain conditions are met.
