Following the implementation of MCCP183-CC Scottish Water is required to send copies of the Gap Site letter(s) within 3 days of the T002 transaction to Licensed Provider allocated new Gap Sites via the allocator.

Following discussions and feedback from Licensed Providers letters may not be required in many/all cases in support of the Licensed Provider contacting the non-household customer and bringing them into charge. The process for retrieving the letter detail, monitoring the allocator and packaging the letter to each Licensed Provider following the T002 is an involved process and can be a significant overhead given the volume of Gap Sites currently being processed.

General Description

Scottish Water understand that providing the letter detail to Licensed Providers can in some cases support customer contact and bringing customers into charge. This MCCP proposes to limit Scottish Waters obligation to provide the letter to Licensed Providers when it is actually required, so at the Licensed Providers request.

This will align and limit the overhead required to when the letter is actually required and where the provision of the letter will add value to the process.

A small change to the Market Code and CSD0101 is required to accommodate such a change.
