## 2. MCCP/OCCP DETAILS

a. ISSUE or DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP/OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

Current CSD drafting requires that a series of verifications, including the successful submission of SPID Data by the owning LP, via the T006.0 or T006.1 transactions (including Customer Classification, SIC Code and RV), and Service Element information by Scottish Water, via the T006.2 or T006.3 transactions, along with relevant meter data, should be undertaken before a 'Partial' SPID can become Tradable (i.e. taken account of in settlement), as effected by a T007 (Notify Connection Complete) transaction being accepted.

The key extract from CSD0101 is as follows:

'The following Steps f through to k, are shown separately for clarity rather than representing sequential steps. The information can be drip-fed as and when the Data Owner becomes aware of the information; however, the Registration will not be complete until all of the SPID Data relevant to the Supply Point and necessary for the Settlement Process has been provided to the CMA.

The Market Audit identified a finding that this check was not being performed adequately:

'The validation checks performed by the Central System are not functioning as required. This may lead to SPIDs being connected inappropriately, therefore adversely impacting the settlement runs and market data set quality.'

The CMA is currently in the process of delivering a fix to the Central Systems to provide an automated check of relevant Service Element information as part of the validation of a T007 transaction seeking to connect a SPID and rendering it 'Tradable', so as to avoid the time, cost and effort involved in assessing 'Partial' (and 'New') SPIDs that also have connection dates and retrospectively allocating Service Elements to render them 'Tradable'.

In light of the practical approach that has been adopted for this fix, it is considered that a change to the wording in the CSD would more precisely reflect how the T007 is being validated and this MCCP seeks to establish that revised CSD wording.

Also, this MCCP identifies that CSD0301 Annex A will be modified to reflect the XML that will be delivered as part of the September Release.
