Currently, an outgoing LP that cancels a registration request is required to provide a justification as to why the rejection should be upheld. If this is for an outstanding debt, a standard summary table of information should be provided by e-mail to the CMA within 24 hours of the rejection from the incumbent LP to the new LP.

There is a material data protection issue in allowing customers' personal information (e.g. billing details, debt details) being shared with another organisation ahead of that organisation being the new contracted party. This would still apply in the event of the information being provided by an intermediary or third party such as the CMA. The only way to mitigate this issue would be for the customer to sign a declaration granting such access, although for the purposes of the proposal this would seem to be a meaningless exercise since the purpose is to give the incoming LP advance warning of potential issues.

Whilst the Data Protection Act only covers sole traders, these make up a considerable proportion of the market, and there would seem little sense in removing the reporting requirement for these customers but leaving it in for others. In addition, even though companies are not covered by the DPA, LPs still have an obligation to respect the confidentiality of their account data.

This paper proposes that the requirement on the incumbent LP to provide detailed information to the CMA on the reasons for a cancellation should be removed from CSD0103.
