## CMA Issue 186, 193 - T015.0 for SS Supply Point using Transaction Date instead of Effective From Date When the Central Systems process a T015.0 Disconnection Declaration for a WS supply point and a TDISC (Temporary Disconnection) is stated, then the associated SS supply point will receive the disconnection as well. Likewise with a REC (Reconnection) specified. Currently the Disconnection/Reconnection Process only uses the stated T015.0 Effective From date for the WS supply point. The associated SS supply point is temp disconnected/reconnected on the present date i.e. the date the transaction is processed. 2. The Central System will be changed so the Disconnection/Reconnection Process will use the Effective From Date of the T015.0 when making any updates relating to Temporary Disconnection or Reconnection of a SS supply point. . The system will no longer undertake the disconnection of the SS Supply Point at the same time as the WS Supply point. The WS Supply Point and the SS Supply point will need to be disconnected separately. Even though no physical disconnection will occur a logical disconnection will have to occur for the SS SPID.
