## A.2. MCCP/OCCP DETAILS

A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

For some time the CMA has maintained a schedule of Additional Services, in accordance with Section 7.3.5 of the Market Code.

Amongst the Additional Services offered by the CMA are both scripted and manual Retrospective Amendments (RAs), as allowed for in Section 5.5.2 (ii) of the Market Code. These services are described in the schedule and include the data formats that are required in order to facilitate the delivery of such RAs.

CSD0105 currently requires that a request for an RA must be submitted via an RA request form. However, this has been found to be impractical and serves no useful purpose. Typically, a data submission in the required format has been taken to be an RA request and this format is equally applicable for RAs which already exist as Additional Services and for any further RAs that a Trading Party may require.

In the latter case, the full assessment process described in CSD0105 would of course need to be followed. However, where the RA already exists as an Additional Service, this process will already have been undertaken and an Additional Service Charge established, based on the practicalities and impact of the RA, although CSD0105 does not currently take account of this.

The absence of an update to the CSD has been identified by the Market Auditor as an issue to be resolved.

## **General Description**

This proposal seeks to modify CSD0105 in two ways, so as to better reflect the current practice and to resolve the Market Audit observation:

- The RA submission pro-forma should be removed, since it is not used under any
  circumstances and RA submissions are more manageably handled via submissions of the
  data to be changed, in the format identified in the schedule of Additional Services and
- The RA assessment process need only be applied for new RAs not already identified in the schedule of Additional Services.
