A.2. MCCP / OCCP DETAILS

A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS

Live Rateable Value and the transition arrangements are go live for charging on the 1st April 2018. MCCP222-CC outlined a number of specific scenarios which affects the maintenance of Live Rateable Value and the RV Transition Flag. Having further reviewed the scenario's there some inconsistencies between MCCP222-CC and the Directions issued to Licensed Providers pursuant to standard licence condition B3.

This MCCP-CC updates the Market Code to align with the Directions. The Directions state:

2.2 SPIDs subject to transition arrangements

Transition charging arrangements apply to all SPIDs:

- With a connection date recorded at the CMA that is earlier than 1 April 2018; and
- Where the recorded unique address reference number (UARN) associated with the premises has a RV assigned to it with an Effective Date earlier than 1 April 2017 (i.e. a RV assigned at the 2010 valuation or pre-2017 valuation); and
- Where the Live RV that was assigned by the LCRA in 2017-18 was not amended as the result of:
 - Full redevelopment of the premises, either the start or end of works undertaken;
 - Merger of multiple premises into a single rated entity;
 - Disaggregation of a single rated entity into multiple individually rated entities; or
 - Addition or removal of an Apportionment Note.

2.3 Termination of the Glide Path

The Retail Glide Path of SPIDs that are being transitioned shall be terminated if during the Transition Period, the relevant premises are:

- Merged into a single rated entity;
- Disaggregated into multiple individually rated entities;
- Completely redeveloped or reconstructed, either the start or end of works; or
- In receipt of an addition or removal of an Apportionment Note.
- Subject to the addition or removal of a meter.
- Re-assessed resulting in unmeasured charges replaced by charges based on a pseudo meter.

There are three further scenarios that will be subject to transition, and as such are not included or subject to

the rules outlined in the table "Circumstances in which SPIDs will not be under transitional charging

arrangements on 1 April 2018" in section 5.6 of CSD0104. The three scenarios consist in:

- **Pre-2017/18 SPID with no historic Live RV –** SPIDs created prior to 01/04/2017 matched to the SAA (UARN), but whose UARN does not have an entry in the pre-2017 valuation; these are generally effective from the 01/04/2017 on the SAA.
- Pre-2017/18 SPID with no historic Live RV (Absence Code) SPIDs created prior to 01/04/2017 without a match to the SAA.
- 2017/18 SPID with no historic Live RV (Absence Code) SPIDs created in 2017/18 without a

match to the SAA.
