A.2. MCCP/OCCP DETAILS

A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

Wave, with the support of Scottish Water, are seeking an additional marker to be placed on the Central Systems to flag the presence of a Scottish Water Emergency Water Plan.

Such premises (currently designated by Scottish Water as all NHS Hospitals, HM Prisons and Hospices) are not presently identified on the Central Systems database. Without the proposed flag it is difficult for Scottish Water and Licensed Providers to maintain an accurate alignment between their respective systems.

Currently, the Operational Code (Non-Household Customer Classification section) provides a framework for the Wholesaler (Scottish Water) to determine which Non-Household Customer sites are designated sensitive and places certain obligations on Licensed Providers to maintain this list as follows:

Non-Household Customer Classification

- Each Licensed Provider will maintain and keep updated a list, approved by the Commission, of their respective Non-Household Customer's Premises whose Non-Household Customers are, as agreed with Scottish Water, vulnerable sections of the community for the purposes of the provision of Water or Sewerage Services which may include specified prisons, nursing homes and other care homes, hospitals, schools and food and drink processors ("Sensitive Customers").
- The Licensed Provider will provide the list of their respective Non-Household Customer's Premises to the Central Market Agency and Scottish Water under the Market Code in order that Sensitive Customers may be separately identified. Such list to be kept updated and submitted promptly to the Central Market Agency and Scottish Water.

All sensitive sites meeting the above criteria are afforded a 'Sensitive Site' marker on the Central System database to clearly distinguish their sensitive status.

In addition to sensitive site status, certain critical sites as determined and interpreted by Scottish Water under the Operational Code are afforded an Emergency Water Plan; to be implemented by Scottish Water in the event of an issue with the public water network which may affect the supply to such sites. In such an instance, Scottish Water would provide additional alternative supplies, mainly in the form of tankered or bottled water.

A.2.b. DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF THE MCCP/OCCP AND HOW IT MEETS THE MARKET CODE / OPERATIONAL CODE OBJECTIVES AND PRINCIPLES FOR THE MARKET DOCUMENTS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (c) and 8.8.1 (ii) (c)

General Description

The provision of an additional flag, in particular, an additional valid entry for the existing D2005 Customer Classification, will assist in providing more accurate records and in the maintenance of the associated emergency plans, their revision and auditing on a regular basis. This forms part of the statutory duties of Wholesaler, Licensed Provider and Customer under the current legislative process and would provide a welcome enhancement to current arrangements.

This proposal also includes an additional notification to Scottish Water, to ensure that SW is in a position to confirm or query the allocation of this new 'Critical Site' status.

The proposal, raised by the Wave Emergency and Contingency Manager, has the full support of Scottish Water.
