A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

As part of its routine assessment of issues arising, the CMA has identified a number of issues associated with the MDS and with the NAPS Report.

These issues may be summarised as follows:

- MDS. The MDS X31 (Water SPIDs) and X32 (Sewerage SPIDs) reports currently include the Consumption Indicator. However, the calculation of the Consumption Indicator is such that it always and necessarily defaults to 0 (i.e. False) in the MDS because the MDS is a daily snapshot, whereas the CI calculation assesses historic advances and can only change from False to True where an actual advance is identified. Meaningful Consumption Indicator values are provided in settlement Disagg Reports.
- MDS. The MDS X31 and X32 reports currently include the D2011 RV and the D2044 RV
 Transition Flag. This is inconsistent with MCCP279 (Discontinuation of RV) in which it has
 been agreed that RV and the transition to Live RV can be removed from the arrangements
 (except for RAs to allow for historic changes to RV) and the information is now redundant.
- NAPS. The NAPS currently searches for the earliest RV value (interpreted as being Live RV or RV, whichever is the earlier), rather than the earliest Live RV.
