The purpose of this MCCP is to capture final refinements to the Market Code and Code Subsidiary Documents (CSDs), required as a consequence of the development of the March 2025 Release, and to consolidate the required Market Code and CSD changes which have already been described in the Approved Changes that form the scope of that Release. The MCCP also picks up inconsistencies and/or gaps identified from previously Approved Changes.

General Description

The following are the additional changes:

CSD0104 Part 1 Maintain SPID Data

MCCP305 would allow LPs to update a Customer Name on any SPID that is not Permanently Disconnected or Deregistered. In reviewing the detail of the T032.0 transaction, we have concluded that Rejected SPIDs also need to be excluded so the change to the wording of CSD0104 Part 1, Section 6.3 has been extended to specify that the LP will update the Customer Name at a "Supply Point that is not Rejected, Deregistered or Permanently Disconnected".

CSD0203 Meter Read Submission Validation

When the validation rejection for positive Candidate Daily Volume following a negative or zero Prior Estimated Daily Volume was removed by MCCP274, the rejection was removed from the table in Section 2.3.1 but was not replaced with a statement that the read had therefore passed validation. A new entry in the table clarifies this together with a new note to clarify that a read that passes Section 2.3.1 can still be rejected by the next check set out in Section 2.3.2.

CSD0301 Data Transaction Catalogue.

- Definition of error codes for future-dated transactions.
- GJ error code is introduced to provide a more accurate description of the rejection of a T012.7 transaction with an Effective From Date before 1/1/1980

- improve the accuracy of settlement and billing
