As part of its routine housekeeping, the CMA has reviewed whether all the message error codes in Section 3.3 of CSD0301 are still used in the live CS.

This review discovered that 14 error codes are no longer returned by any transaction or RA and can therefore be described as "no longer used" in CSD0301 and renamed in the CS XSD.

The 14 redundant error codes are listed in section A.2.d of this change proposal.
