A.2.a. ISSUE OR DEFECT WHICH THIS MCCP / OCCP SEEKS TO ADDRESS Required under Market Code Parts 8.7.1 (ii) (b) and 8.8.1 (ii) (b)

When Scottish Water undertakes a non-Market Meter exchange, the End Read of the old meter, the Opening Read of the new meter, and the details of the new meter are not notified to the LPs who have SPIDs associated with the meter network that includes the non-Market Meter.

This means that LPs may not be aware of the change and may bill Customers incorrectly as a result.

Once aware that an exchange has taken place, LPs may still spend significant time establishing the details of the meter exchange.

General Description

This MCCP would update the T017.0 (Submit Meter Swap) and T017.1 (Notify Meter Swap) transactions so that, where the meter in question is a non-Market Meter the T017.1 notification will also go to the LP (or LPs if they are different for the water and sewerage SPID) with a SPID associated with the parent meter of the non-Market Meter in that meter network.

CSD0106 (Non-Market Meters), Section 3.1.2 shall be updated to include an additional step.

Step c: CMA notifies Licensed Providers: [T017.1]

Although the non-Market Meter is not associated with a SPID, the non-Market Meter will most probably be part of a Meter Network that impacts the settlement of SPIDs registered to Licensed Providers.

Within one Business Day, the CMA shall identify the Main Meter for the Meter Network including the non-Market Meter that has been exchanged and shall identify the SPIDs associated with those that Main Meter and shall notify the relevant Licensed Provider(s) of the exchange of the non-Market Meter through the T017.1 transaction.

Note that in a multi-level Meter Network the "Main Meter" of the Non-Market Meter is not necessarily the Meter at the top of the network. It may itself be a Sub-Meter of another Meter.

UR 1 Amendments to T017.0 transaction processing. Where a T017.0 transaction does not have the D2001 SPID populated and the validation checks show that this is valid, the processing logic shall be amended to include additional steps.

UR 1.1 The Main Meter in the Meter Network where the exchanged meter is the Sub Meter shall be identified. If there is none then no further change shall be made to the processing logic.

UR 1.2 The meter identified in UR 1.1 shall be checked to establish whether it is associated with a SPID. If the meter is not then no further action shall be taken in relation to that meter.

UR 1.3 Where the MeterID is associated with a SPID, the OrgID for the LPs to which the SPID (and any associated SPID) is registered shall be identified.

UR 1.4 The T017.1 notification shall be sent to all LPs identified in UR 1.3 as well as to Scottish Water.
